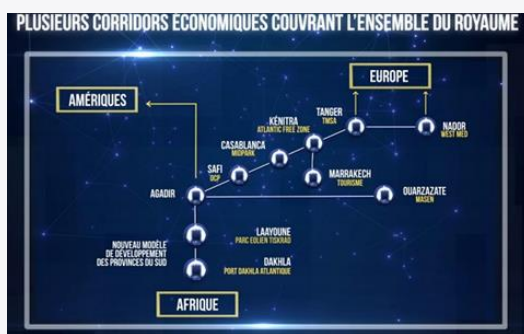
Ethiopia - Ethiopia's latest industrial park is located in the Oromia region + Other upcoming industrial parks.

Morocco - The Export Free Zone of Souss-Massa region of Agadir, on track

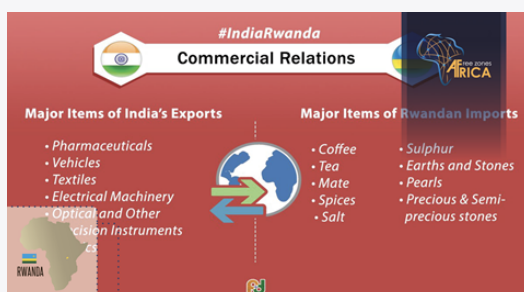
Morocco - The Souss-Massa Export Free Zone project in the Agadir region is taking shape. The platform will enhance the attractiveness of the region and attract export-oriented and job-creating activities. It will cover 300 hectares and provide access to industrial land with international standards and competitive prices. This free zone will comprise 11 sectors, including the naval industry, whose infrastructure will commit nearly 500 M EUR of investment at the national level.

Morocco - Strategic partnership between Morocco and Quebec in the aerospace industry.

Morocco, represented by the Ministry of Industry and GIMAS, has signed a partnership agreement with Aéro Montréal, Quebec's aerospace cluster. This agreement aims to identify opportunities to take part in international and local projects and programs, as well as opportunities for rapprochement between Moroccan and Quebec companies, with the aim of supporting the consolidation of supply chains.
